DANCE GUIDELINES FOR CLHS SPONSORED DANCES

Student dances are an acceptable part of the co-curricular activities at Crean Lutheran High School and are a wholesome activity if properly conducted.

GUIDELINES

1. These evening affairs normally starting at 7:00 PM or earlier and concluding by 10:00 PM. Special extensions of time may be granted by administration permission only. **No admission is granted after 8:00 PM** without prior arrangements with the Activities Coordinator.

2. Crean Lutheran High School students currently enrolled may be admitted with their **student identification card** and ticket. Normally tickets are to be purchased on campus prior to the event, however, exceptions may be made for casual dances. Tickets may be sold at the door depending on prior arrangements. <u>Non-CLHS students</u> <u>must complete a guest contract and include a copy of a photo school ID or driver's license.</u>

3. Guest contracts can be obtained and returned to the CLHS office by the marked deadline date. One (1) guest per CLHS student only. No guests younger than 9th grade or older than 1 year removed from high school are allowed. All Guest Pass Agreements are subject to approval by CLHS Administration and may be denied. The CLHS Student assumes responsibility for their guest's behavior and dress and will make every attempt to ensure that his/her guest adhere to our school's purpose and behavior expectations.

4. Appropriate dress is expected. Dress is semiformal at special dances such as Homecoming, Winter Formal and Prom. Please note the following, semi formal means:

- Students should observe modesty in daily dress and appearance. No bare midriffs allowed for students.
- Spaghetti straps or strapless dresses are OK as long as dress is "tasteful," which means not too short, too tight, too low, or too revealing.
- All skirts and shorts must be no shorter than fingertip length when hands are at your side. Students who choose to wear these will be asked to change. No spandex shorts, track shorts, or running shorts will be permitted.
- Body piercing is only allowed for female students in the ear lobe. Ear piercing should reflect modesty and should not be oversized or distracting. Male students may not wear ear piercings, including clear studs.
- All other piercing is not permitted on campus including eyebrow, tongue, and nose.
- Body art and tattoos should not be visible. Students with tattoos should wear clothing that covers the tattoo or body art.

The staff has the right to say what is appropriate. All other dress code guidelines are expected to be followed. Repeat offenders will be issued dress code infractions.

5. Enforcement of Dress Code

Students out of dance dress code will not be permitted to enter the dance. Parents will be notified and the student will need to change in order to be admitted into the dance. Students refusing to follow dress code will not receive a refund if they do not follow dress code.

6. All Students will be subject to a search of pockets and handbags.

- 1. The Zero Tolerance policy includes all school events on or off campus (including E-cigarettes or vaporizers).
- 2. No inappropriate or sexually explicit dancing.
- 3. All students receive a <u>wristband</u> upon entrance to the dance. If the student violates dance rules or regulations in any way, i.e. dress code or inappropriate dancing or behavior, the wristband is marked with an X as a warning. If there is a second offense, the student will be removed from the event and parents will be notified immediately and admission into the next dance will be under consideration.

7. All regular school guidelines for behavior shall apply. Parents are to be notified immediately should a student refuse to follow established behavior standards. Parents may be requested to come and get the student from the activity if the circumstances warrant such action.

- 1. There is no loitering in the immediate vicinity or parking lot adjoining the dance area and there is to be no re-admission after leaving.
- 2. Students are expected to stay for the entire duration of the dance. CLHS will sign students out that leave one half hour or earlier prior to the events ending time. CLHS is not responsible for students once they have left the event.

ANY VIOLATIONS OF THE ABOVE RULES WILL RESULT IN THE FORFEITURE OF THE TICKET COST, LOSS OF ADMISSION TO THE DANCE AND FUTURE DISCIPLINARY ACTION AS REQUIRED.

The Zero Tolerance Policy states, "Be it resolved that a student who at any time is in possession of illegal drugs, alcohol, or a dangerous weapon on the Crean Lutheran High School campus will immediately be expelled from school."

All students attending Crean Lutheran dances may be subject to a breathalyzer test before, during, or after the event. Any bags brought to dances may be searched before admittance to the dance.
